Dreyer's Produce & Greenhouse has been in operations since 1960. In 1988, current owner Ed Dreyer III bought the farm from his father to continue the family business. Since then, Dreyer's Produce & Greenhouse has evolved from growing 18 different commodity items to now only growing peppers, eggplant, and hard squash on the Dreyer's 70 acre farm. They made this switch 15 years ago when they started using Superior Sales, Inc. Ed Dreyer claims that since they have reduced the amount of commodities they produce farming has become much easier.

Ed has help on the farm from his two sons, Joel and Josh. He hopes that having his sons involved in the operation, will translate to them sharing the passion he has for growing as his father did before him.
