An article on mlive.com today identified the top 50 school districts in Michigan based on their M-STEP performance. As you know the M-STEP assessment is given to students in grades 3-8 and 11. The results show Rockford did very well.

- All subjects combined: Rockford 10th in the state
- Mathematics: Rockford 11th in the state
- English Language Arts: Rockford 10th in the state
- · Science: Rockford 5th in the state

At last night's Board of Education meeting the following items of interest were discussed:

Our Grow Your Own program update

• This is our effort to recruit and train more teachers funded with a grant from the state of Michigan. We currently have 85 staff participating in this program.

Bus inspection report

- · Our buses are inspected each year by the Michigan Department of Transportation. This year was another very positive report. We have 66 buses. There are 3 categories: Green, Yellow, Red. We had 64 green, 1 yellow, and 1 red.
- As a point of clarification, a red tag identifies an important issue but not necessarily one that would render the bus undriveable. This year's red tag was a concern that one gas tank had a leak. The mechanics examined the bus tank and could not find the leak. We felt it might have been diesel from the hose used to fill up the tank leaking onto the tank.

Bond/construction update
